At the same time the help provided by our numerous supporters meant that we were able to intensify our global project activities, enter into new partnerships and cooperative ventures with businesses and so reach even more disadvantaged children and young people.

We are especially grateful for the rising number of **interest-free loans** entrusted to Jugend Eine Welt in 2019. Among the activities these loans help fund are **education projects** in India, Benin and elsewhere.

Our very special thanks are due to those donors who **bequeathed money** to Jugend Eine Welt in their wills. Their gifts continue to bear fruit and do good all over the world! As a mark of gratitude and in remembrance of these donors, Jugend Eine Welt last year erected a statue of St. John Bosco in Hietzing cemetery which bears this quote of his: "God bless and reward all our donors!"

Active in many fields: Our partner organisations and initiatives


We are particularly delighted that the service point for voluntary assignments abroad, **WeltWegWeiser**, launched by Jugend Eine Welt and supported by the **Austrian Development Agency**, won recognition in 2019 in the form of an award for inclusion. WeltWegWeiser promotes voluntary assignments abroad for people with disabilities.

Jugend Eine Welt's partner organisation **VOLONTARIAT bewegt**, which arranges assignments abroad for adolescents and young adults, was also able to send out many members of that group to Don Bosco social projects all over the world.

The Jugend Eine Welt programme that organises periods of voluntary work for people with professional experience, **Senior Experts Austria**, continued to grow in 2019, while the Jugend Eine Welt **education team** continued its efforts to raise awareness of topics relating to development cooperation among school pupils in Austria.

We are equally pleased that the **Don Bosco Flüchtlingswerk** (renamed Don Bosco Sozialwerk in 2020) was able to celebrate its 15th anniversary last year. The **Jugend Eine Welt Not-for-profit Private Foundation** also continues to grow and its specifically dedicated aid fund is an important element of the work done by Jugend Eine Welt. We hope that the number of donors will continue to grow.

The **Don Bosco Green Alliance** was also very active in the past year. Jugend Eine Welt already supports several of the Don Bosco Green Clubs in the Alliance, and in 2019 an exchange visit to Uganda took place to this end.









Also in 2019, the next large contingent of committed young people left Austria for a period of work abroad.



Talk by a former street child

To mark Street Children's Day, Jugend Eine Welt organised events in Vienna, Tyrol and Upper Austria – with engrossing talks by Lokesh Kumar from India. The successful actor from Bangalore was once a street child himself, and gave Jugend Eine Welt's guests a moving account of his life. It was a marvellous and instructive thing to witness!



Experience helps!

With the support of the Pühringer Privatstiftung, an evening event took place in the spring of 2019 that presented the idea of periods of voluntary work abroad for people with professional experience and the Jugend Eine Welt scheme that organises them, Senior Experts Austria. Numerous prominent guests accepted the invitation to Palais Coburg in Vienna to discuss the possibilities and opportunities afforded by voluntary assignments for people with professional experience.



Shoe-cleaning campaign for Street Children's Day

31 January | In 2019 another symbolic shoe-cleaning campaign was held on Stephansplatz in Vienna on Street Children's Day to draw attention to the plight of child labourers. A hardy group of socially aware young volunteers braved the freezing temperatures to clean shoes and so make a statement against child poverty and child labour. Cleaning shoes instead of going to school – this is still the harsh everyday reality for far too many young people around the globe.



Project visit to Bethlehem

In May 2019 two Jugend Eine Welt staff members travelled to Bethlehem to visit Don Bosco projects there, discuss possible forms of support and see how the donations made by our donors are making a difference. In Palestine there are several Don Bosco schools which offer the only chance of education for many children and teenagers from the poorest families.


World Day Against Child Labour

To mark the annual World Day Against Child Labour in June, Jugend Eine Welt highlighted the plight of approximately 73 million children worldwide who are forced to work in inhuman and exploitative conditions and have virtually no chance of an education. Child labour continues to provide elements of many products that we in Europe use every day, such as smartphones and cosmetics.



Volunteers launch fundraising campaign

In the spring of 2019, Konstantin and Johannes did a period of voluntary work in Ecuador, helping schoolchildren at a Don Bosco institution with their lessons. While they were there, the government cancelled the subsidy it had previously granted for meals. The two dedicated young Austrians promptly launched a successful fundraising campaign and were able to save "their" pupils' daily school meals – which for many of them was the only time they ate during the day.



Vergissmeinnicht: A thank-you for all the bequests

As a member of the "Vergissmeinnicht" ("forget-me-not") scheme, Jugend Eine Welt planted the flowers of that name in April as a symbolic thank-you. Our thanks went to all those donors who remembered Jugend Eine Welt in their wills and are therefore continuing to do good even after their passing.





15 years of the Don Bosco Flüchtlingswerk

In July the Don Bosco Flüchtlingswerk, which was renamed Don Bosco Sozialwerk in 2020, celebrated its 15th anniversary with a colourful summer party. Jugend Eine Welt, as one of the organisations that co-founded the facility for unaccompanied minors and shares responsibility for it, was naturally there as well, and celebrated this landmark along with the Flüchtlingswerk management, the hostel residents and many other guests.



Centre for women opens in Burkina Faso

Thanks to the generous help of Jugend Eine Welt's donors an education centre for women was opened in Burkina Faso in September. The centre provides a meeting place for women and girls of all ages and makes a vital contribution to reducing illiteracy and unemployment.



Project visit to Uganda

In the summer of last year a member of Jugend Eine Welt's staff visited the Don Bosco Green Club in Uganda with a former volunteer. Workshops on environmental protection were held there, as was a symbolic tree-planting. The Green Clubs are part of the Don Bosco Green Alliance that is committed to environmental protection worldwide and raises awareness for the environment among young people.



Teacher without frontiers

In the autumn of 2019, Sonja Hanappi began her period of voluntary work organised by the Jugend Eine Welt assignment programme Senior Experts Austria. The experienced teacher travelled to India where she taught elementary school children and held training courses for local teachers. We are delighted at such great dedication!



This gives you the certainty that your donation is used in accordance with your intentions.





For an organisation to be awarded the seal of approval, an independent audit of its accounts and publication of a financial report on the basis of this audit are required. Every euro donated to Jugend Eine Welt is an expression of trust in us. That is why transparency is so important to us. Because it is only thanks to this trust, only thanks to the support of our donors, that we were once again able to reach so many children and young people in need during the past year. Thank you for your help in 2019!


